### Toronto OYMI Music Festival

The festival participants must read through all the rules and regulations before registering specific classes. Please read carefully before registering classes.

- In order to participate in the CAST (Chinese Arts Society of Toronto)
   Philomusica Orchestra Concerto competition class, participants are required to enter additional **TWO** classes minimum. Winners will have an opportunity to perform with the CAST Philomusica Orchestra and OYMCO as a soloist in the 2024-2025 season.
- 2. In order to be eligible to receive OYMI Young Artists Contract Awards\*, participants must enter minimum **THREE** or more classes. Failure to participate in any of the classes entered will result in withdrawal of the OYMI Young Artists Contract Awards.
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded to 2024 OYMI Music Festival Young Artists Contract Awards Winners. Winners will be decided based on marks, recommendation, stage presence, and musicianship. Some Contract Award Winners may have an opportunity to perform as a soloist with OYMCO (Outstanding Young Musicians Chamber Orchestra)
- 4. All classes can be registered multiple times as needed. All repertoires can be played once only from the same year of the competition. Repeated repertoires will not be accepted. Repeated registered classes must have different repertoires each time.
- 5. The participant must be born after January 01, 1996, all age requirements are as of **January 01, 2024**.
- 6. All performances must be memorized, unless identified, non-memorized performances will result in automatic deduction of marks.
- 7. If there is a time limit set for the class, the adjudicator has the right to stop the participant at any point. Marks will not be affected.
- 8. All participants are eligible to attend Masterclasses, with 3 or more classes registered.
- 9. The competition will be held in person.
- 10. Piano accompaniment is required for all classes, unless the repertoire does not require piano accompaniment.
- 11. Strings participants must have the instrument tuned before going up on stage. Participants may briefly tune on stage.



- 12. All participants must bring the original score to the festival for the adjudicators, no photocopies are allowed.
- 13. All entries must be registered and paid in full before the deadline of **April 26<sup>th</sup>**, **2024**.



# Section 01 — CAST (Chinese Arts Society of Toronto) Philomusica Orchestra Concerto Competition

In order to enter this class, participants **must enter TWO** additional classes. This class is open to participants of all ages. Minimum level requirement is RCM Level 8. Orchestra reduction will be played on a second piano. Accompanist must be brought by participants. Memorization is required. Time requirement: under 14 minutes. This class in not restricted to concerto pieces only, concert pieces with orchestra accompaniment in the original score are accepted as well. (For example, Rachmaninoff's Variations on a theme by Paganini). If the participants decide to enter the Concerto Class (Section 02 - Concerto), they may use the same piece as this section.

Repeated repertoires will not be accepted. Repeated registered classes must have different repertoires each time. Open Age.

This class in not restricted to concerto pieces only, concert pieces with orchestra accompaniment in the original score are accepted as well. (For example but not limited to, Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso by Saint-Saëns, Poeme op. 25 by Chausson, Rococo Variations by Tchaikovsky).

### Section 04 — Chamber Music Ensemble

Open to students of all age and instruments. Ensemble must have at least 2 members and no more than 6 members. Some examples of the chamber ensembles qualified for the entry are piano violin duo, string duo, piano trio, string trio, string quartet, piano quintet etc. Repertoires are not limited to RCM syllabus. Students are not required to perform the piece memorized. Original copy of the score must be given to the adjudicator. Participants wishing to perform more than one piece may sign up for the same class multiple times. All repertoires can be played once only from the same year of the competition. Repeated repertoires will not be accepted. Repeated registered classes must have different repertoires each time.

All repertoires can be played once only from the same year of the competition. Repeated repertoires will not be accepted. Repeated registered classes must have different repertoires each time.
